### GUINNESS \$5.00/16.00

*St. James's Gate Brewery* - Dublin, Ireland  
Irish Stout, Black and Perfect. Topped with a shamrock for the pure of heart.

### OLD SPECKLED HEN \$4.50/14.00

*Morland's of Abingdon* - Oxfordshire, England  
A premium pale ale; made at the second oldest English brewery and named for a car.

### WOODY'S WHEAT \$4.50/14.00

*Sandcreek Brewing Company* - Black River Falls, Wisconsin  
A classic hefe-weizen; lightly hopped, with a smooth finish and clove and banana overtones.

### ROTATING TAP \$4.50/14.00

*Ask your server.*

### NORTHERN HONEY BROWN LAGER \$4.00/12.00

*Cold Spring Brewing Co.* - Cold Spring, Minnesota  
This dark, American-style lager puts just the right amount of Minnesota honey with the right amount of hops; creating a slight malt flavor and a smooth honey flavor that fades to a crisp, dry finish.

### KÜL LITE \$3.00/8.00

*LaCrosse City Brewery* - LaCrosse, Wisconsin  
A great tasting premium light beer from the mid-west.

### MOJO I.P.A. \$4.50/14.00

*Rockies Brewing Company* - Boulder, Colorado  
A very strong and hoppy IPA with 7% Alc/Vol and 70 IBU's.  
This is one of the best India pale ales made.

### BADGER PORTER \$4.50/14.00

*Sandcreek Brewing Company* - Black River Falls, Wisconsin  
This velvety ale is brewed from a duo of Belgian and American dark-roasted malts. When poured, its deep garnet color is crowned with a creamy tan head.

### SMITHWICK'S IMPORTED IRISH ALE \$4.50/14.00

*Smithwick's Brewery* - Kilkenny, Ireland  
Smithwick's brewery, built around the ruins of the St. Francis Abbey, dates back to 1710. The brewery, Ireland's oldest and now owned by Guinness, produces this soft, red draught ale.
